A luncheon is planned for Sunday, June 28th, at noon at

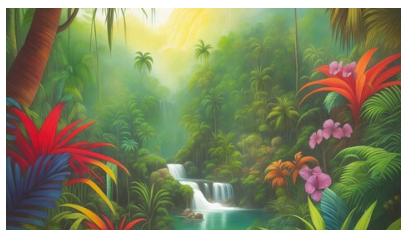
