Ash Wednesday Service, Wednesday, March 5 at 7pm at St. John's. Ashes will be offered for those who wish them.

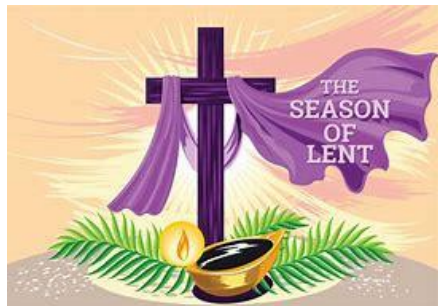
